Northern Utah Powered Parachute Fly-In

We are pleased to invite all interested powered parachute pilots and friends to an informal Spring Fly-In to be held at Northern Utah's Cedar Valley Airport over the Memorial Day weekend of 2018. Here are some details:

When:

The main event will take place on Friday and Saturday, May 25 - 26, 2018. Feel free to come or go earlier or later. You may wish to arrive Thursday for possible evening flying and to be ready for early morning flying on Friday. In addition, you may want to extend your stay into Sunday and/or Monday if desired (see Optional Monday Activity note below).

Where

Cedar Valley Airport (UT-10) is located about 30 miles Southwest of Salt Lake City. You can enter "Cedar Valley Airport Utah" or "UT-10" in most GPS units for directions. Or, from I-15, just take Exit 279 (which is Lehi Main Street and Utah Highway 73); go west on Highway 73 for 10 miles and turn left at the CEDAR VALLEY AIRPORT sign.

(Note: at about 5 miles from the freeway, Highway 73 bends to the left to a stop light. Turn right at the light and continue west. There are mile markers on the left side of the road which count down. The airport road is just past Mile Marker 31.)

What

Lots of open and group flying, games, competitions, forums, and a lot of opportunity to rub shoulders with other pilots. Saturday night Bar-B-Q.

Camping

There is plenty of space for RV and Tent Camping but no hookups.

Some requirements:

All pilots wishing to fly will be required to sign a waiver and to attend a daily briefing.

Spectators and Intro flights

The public is invited to come to the event. Some may be interested in getting an introductory flight. Currently licensed pilots with currently legal PPCs who wish to offer such flights will be issued special name tags for identification.

Optional Monday Activity

On Monday, May 28 (Memorial Day) we have been invited to do a fly-over at a Veterans' Memorial event in Midway, Utah, about an hour's drive east of Cedar Valley Airport. We will drive to Midway Monday morning and set up at a field near Memorial Hill for some open flying. There will be a motorcycle ride and a fun-run which will culminate at the hill and at a nearby open air theater and that's when we will do the fly-over. We hope to decorate our PPCs with flags and/or colored streamers to add to the festivities.
